

American Association of University Women (AAUW) Wooster Branch Scholarship

Who can apply?

This scholarship is available to female residents of Wayne County whose post-secondary education was interrupted by financial or family issues. It is for nontraditional students enrolled or planning to enroll in a qualified, accredited undergraduate associate and/or bachelor's degree program. It is not for students coming directly out of high school, nor for persons pursuing a graduate degree.

What can the scholarship funds be used for?

Awards (ranging from \$500 to \$2500) are based on available funds, can be used for tuition and fees (not including room and board) required for enrollment; and for fees, books, supplies and equipment directly required for your course of instruction. The scholarship must be used within the year granted. Prior recipients may reapply.

What are the application requirements?

- A completed application form (attached).
- A one-page personal statement describing your career goals and including any additional information that might support your application.
- A transcript of any college level grades and classes (if applicable), or a letter of acceptance from an accredited degree program.
- **Three** letters of recommendation from an employer, professor, academic advisor, or a member of a civic or charitable organization. (No more than one letter from a clergy person or friend will be accepted.) References should submit their letters directly to the postal box indicated below.
- A resume (optional).

What is the selection process?

A committee of AAUW members reviews applications and recommends awards to the Board of the Wooster Branch of AAUW. The Wooster AAUW Board acts on the committee recommendations and their decision is final. Awards are based on the quality of the application, letters of recommendation, financial need, career goals and community and/or professional involvement. If the awarded funds are not used within a one -year period, they will be forfeited. Monies are dispersed only to the student's account at their particular school. Scholarship recipients will be notified by June 15, 2021 and given instructions on how to access their award. Funds will be available after July 1, 2021.
